Child's Absence

If your child is not in school for whatever reason please inform the school office by 9.30am on the first day of absence. It is really important that we are updated **daily** when a child is unwell to ensure symptoms are monitored very closely given current circumstances. Thank you for your help with this.

We are pleased to let you know that we will be participating in the Bag2School collection again this term and the date for collection will be Friday 16th October. This scheme allows us to get paid for collecting unwanted clothing and other items, a great way of recycling for cash! However, this collection will be slightly different in that we will be unable to accept and store any bags at school before the collection date, and we are not being provided with B2S bags. We would ask that you place items to be donated in your own sealed bags and bring them to school at drop off on the morning of Friday 16th October. There will be an easily identified area of the car park where you can place the bags. Please have a sort out at home!
