IMPORTANT INFORMATION - "Track and Trace" – Easter Break

We really hope that all families can keep safe and well over the coming Easter break, but **should your child who has been attending school develop Covid-19 symptoms on either Friday 2nd or Saturday 3rd April and <u>subsequently</u> tests positive**, would you please notify the school immediately on the office email address <u>office@upperbeeding.w-</u> <u>sussex.sch.uk</u>.

In the unfortunate event of us receiving notification that a child in school has tested positive within this timescale, a member of staff will contact parents of any children identified as being in close contact with the positive case. Any such children will have to self-isolate for 10 days after the last day of contact with the positive case.

We will be monitoring the office emails up until midday on Wednesday 7th April.

The main symptoms of coronavirus are (most people will have at least one of these symptoms):

- **a high temperature** this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **a new, continuous cough** this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

The newly updated government guidelines with the 'rule of six' marks the start of our country's slow recovery from COVID-19, providing a much-needed chance to meet and reconnect with friends, family and loved ones outside, following our time apart.
