Children in school will have the opportunity to see the dress rehearsal of the show during school time. Actual tickets will not be issued for these shows to save paper and cut costs, but they must be purchased via sQuid to secure a seat. If you have not yet purchased your initial 1 or 2 tickets, please do so TODAY as waiting list requests will be allocated tomorrow.
