We greatly value the arts here at Upper Beeding and are constantly looking for new ideas to enhance the creative curriculum. The performance starts at 10:15am so we will be leaving school by coach at 9:00am and returning at approximately 1:45pm. **All children will need a packed lunch on this day**, and should also bring a fruit/veg snack and a drink with them (no glass or breakable bottles please).

If your child may suffer from travel sickness on this visit, please ask the school office for a form so that we are aware of medication taken before the trip, and any medication that may be required for the journey home. Please make sure any travel medication provided is in the original packaging and clearly marked with your child's name.

To help towards the cost of this amazing whole school adventure, we would ask for a voluntary contribution of **£22.50** per child. We would really love all the children to be able to participate in this, but sadly, if we don't receive sufficient contributions, we may not be able to go ahead with this event. Your payment will include contributions towards the pantomime tickets, insurance, and transport to and from Worthing. If you have any difficulty with making this contribution, please speak to your child's teacher, the school office, or Mr Andrews in confidence. sQuid has been set up allowing for instalments to be made, rather than having to pay the full amount in one go, as we appreciate there are often a lot of demands on your wallet at the start of a term, and even more so if you have more than one child in education. Please can we ask that payment is made by 15th November which is when we have to purchase the tickets.
