Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you so much for all your help over the last couple of weeks supporting school events and raising money for the school and Children in Need. Through your generosity, we have raised over £400 for the school to buy new books and over £500 for Children in Need. We had a fabulous Maths Week and it was lovely to see parents back in school at workshops, watching your class assembly and being with your children.



**Colder Weather** A gentle reminder to ensure your children come in with a suitable named warm coat and clothing so they can play outside during break and lunchtime. Gloves, scarves and hats are also beginning to be worn – please can you make sure these are also named. Thank you.

Lost Property We have a large amount of un-named items in our lost property cupboard, so if anybody has lost anything, please pop in to the office and ask!

Covid-19 Unfortunately, we have a number of Covid cases in two classes in Y1/2. We have spoken with UKPHA and they are very confident in all that we are doing as a school with our cleaning, ventilation and organisation. They recommend that all children in the two classes affected have PCR tests and, if negative, to do daily lateral flow tests before coming into school; children are generally asymptomatic or just experiencing a very slight sore throat/sniffles/and/or headache.

**General Government Advice re Self-isolation** Anyone with symptoms of Covid-19 should book a PCR test (not lateral flow) and isolate whilst waiting for the results. If a member of your household contracts Covid-19, the current advice is for all other household members to also have a PCR test; provided the other household members are not displaying symptoms, are under 18 or double vaccinated, they do not need to isolate whilst waiting for test results. If you have any queries at all, please do contact the School Office.

**Christmas Countdown** Christmas Day is in 33 days! We are celebrating the lead up to Christmas at school in a variety of ways and are hoping that we can still do everything we have planned. This could, however, be subject to us possibly re-introducing some further health and safety measures to keep everyone as safe as we can in school, for example, social distanced seating and wearing of face masks indoors (for visitors).

**Christmas Lunch** We are delighted to let you know that we will be having our Christmas lunch on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> December. You have been emailed the menu.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who normally have a hot meal will automatically have a festive meal on this day. If your child does not normally have hot school meals but would like a festive lunch,

The festive lunch is also open to all children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 at a cost of £2.33 (except those children in receipt of Free School Meals, for whom there will be no charge).
