School Uniform Now shops are re-opening I hope that school uniform and school shoes are easier to get. Gentle reminder that school shoes (preferably now not boots) are black or brown and socks are black, white, navy or grey. Please make sure that all school clothes are named as due to the variations in weather, children are leaving items of clothing all around the school as they get hot!

As the weather gets warmer, can I remind you that summer uniform can also be worn. We still expect children to wear suitable shoes to school - either black or brown shoes / sandals. Please could sandals have a back on them and offer a secure foothold. Flip-flops and crocs are not suitable for school. It is also

useful for children to have a waterproof in their bag and a sun hat.

We do have a selection of girls' summer dresses and boys' tailored shorts in our pre-loved uniform store priced £1 each. Please email the school office with your requirements.

PE Kit Can I also ask that you make sure your child has their PE kit in school every day with suitable shoes to wear outside, e.g. trainers, and that everything is clearly **named**. Thank you.

Books Please could we ask you all to have a look at home for any books that belong to school. They will have our name stamped on the inside cover and they could also have coloured strips on the edge. Thank you in advance for your help – we are missing quite a few.



Class Photos – Wednesday 28th April We are really pleased that our school photographer will be in school (following Government guidance) to take our class photos and Year 6 leavers' photos. Please make sure that children are wearing correct uniform on Wednesday.
