Dear Parent/Carer

It has been lovely to see the children enjoying this lovely weather and although it has broken today, we are hoping the sunshine will return.

Changes to Plans We are really disappointed that due to the recent Government announcement, West Sussex County Council guidance and a review of our Covid-19 Risk assessment, we are unable to continue with some of our planned events with parent participation. We are also having to move some dates of events so we can still give children the opportunity to take part in as many activities we can. School leaders, together with Governors and staff, have spent many hours reviewing all the different options and guidance and have focussed on the safety and wellbeing of children and staff. Please see below the changes we have had to make:

- New Entrants Welcome Meeting on 22nd June at 6:00pm will still take place, but will now be a virtual event see letter sent out yesterday to new entrant parents.
- Sports Day with parents' attendance on 1st July will no longer take place; we will have sports events for the children to take part in, but at a different time and still encompassing a 'sports day' feel.
- Year Group Welcome Meetings for parents will now be held virtually and the link will be sent out nearer the time.
 - Y1/2 Welcome Meeting will now be Wednesday 14th July at 4:00pm
 - \circ Y3/4 Welcome Meeting will be Thursday 15th July at 4:00pm
 - Y5/6 Welcome Meeting will be Thursday 15th July at 4:45pm
- Transition morning for the children to meet their new class teacher has been moved to Monday 19th July.
- Year 6 transition day to secondary school has now moved to virtual activities in school Y6 parents should have received an email from the secondary school your child will be attending with information about the virtual and transitional events they are holding.
- Y1/2 visit to Brighton Seafront and Hove Lagoon is unable to take place. Instead, we have planned a fun seaside themed day in school on Monday 28th June. A letter from KS1 with more information will come out next week.
- We are seeking further advice, but currently the Y5/6 production performance will not take place for parents on July 5th / 6th. We will be filming the production for parents and are looking into what else we can do.
- Reception class visit to Washbrook Farm will currently still take place on Thursday 24th June.
- Y6 Leavers' Assembly will currently go ahead as planned with parents present on Tuesday 20th July at 10:00am.
- Y6 Leavers' Party will also go ahead as planned on Tuesday 20th July, 4:00 6:00pm.

None of these decisions have been made lightly and I fully understand how disappointing this is for everyone involved. Thank you for your understanding and support as we continue with the rest of this term.
