P.E.

Your child will receive their weekly spellings every Monday morning and will be tested on these words the following week. We would be grateful if you could help your child to learn these words in addition to the spelling activities provided in class.



HEALTHY LUNCH BOXES

As part of our aim to provide our children with healthy life styles, we would like to remind you that your child should be provided with a healthy packed lunch. If your child would like a snack at break time, please can you ensure it is a piece of fruit or vegetables, such as carrot sticks. Please do not send your child to school with nuts, peanut butter or products containing nuts as we do have children in school who are severely allergic to

such items.

WATER BOTTLES



Your child should have a named plastic bottle of drinking water to have in class; these should not be used for squash or fruit juice please. Children are encouraged to fill these up at the start of the day and during break and lunchtimes. During the summer months, it is strongly
