Dear Parent/Carer

I hope you have all had an enjoyable and restful Summer. We are so proud of how the children returned back to school this week. It has been wonderful to hear them laughing, singing and to have the Beeding Buzz back!

I'd like to give an especially big welcome to our new Reception children, with some joining us this week with the rest to follow next.

Thank you to those of you who have introduced yourselves at the school gate in the morning. I look forward to getting to know the school community better over the coming weeks.

Thank you all also for your support in the systems we have put in place to keep our children safe. Please see a reminder below of the protocols we have in place so all our children are happy, safe and can enjoy their time in school.

What time will school start and finish?

- All children should arrive between 8:45am and 8:55am; registration closes at 9:00 and if they arrive after this time, they will be marked as late.
- Reception children will finish at 3:10pm
- KS1 and KS2 children will finish at 3:15pm

Where is my child dropped off in the morning and picked up in the afternoon?

We are continuing with the same drop off system we had last year as it worked really well, enabling the children to settle into class really quickly. Mr Hughes, Mrs Quigley and myself will be at the gates at the main school and a member of Y5/6 will be at the Church Lane gate.

Pick up arrangements At the end of the day the school gates will be open for KS1 and KS2 parents to meet their children on the playground or by the back exit door of the classroom.

- Y1/2 and Y3/4 children will all exit out of their classroom exit doors and leave via the side gate by Kenya class.
- We encourage Year 5/6 children to walk to and from school by themselves to reduce the number of people around the school premises and they will all exit via the Church Lane gate.















- Reception staff will bring the children to the Reception gate and hand over to waiting parents.
- All parents and children will need to have left school grounds by 3:30pm so we can lock the side gates and we would respectfully ask that you do not let younger siblings run around the adventure trail or use any school equipment.

The school car-park will still be out of use to all parents at both drop off and pick up times unless there are significant exceptional circumstances agreed with the school in advance.

How do I get a message to or speak to my child's class teacher? Please email or call the school office. Alternatively email the class teachers directly, their emails are all on the school website in the Staff List section. There will also be an opportunity at the end of the day for a quick chat or to pass on a message outside of the classroom.



Messages regarding changes to pick up arrangements that day should be emailed or phoned to the school office **before 12 noon**. After 12 contact should be by telephone only as it cannot be guaranteed that emails will be read and messages distributed before the end of the afternoon session.

Mobile Phones If children in Year 5/6 have to bring a mobile phone to school with them, it will be their responsibility to hand to class teachers at the beginning of each day and collect again at the end of the day. All mobile phones must be turned off and they will be locked away for the day. If children do not follow this expectation, we will ask them not to bring their phones to school.

What type of school shoes should my child wear? These should be either <u>all black or all navy</u> and preferably shoes not trainers; children can bring trainers in to change into for lunchtime play. Children will also need trainers / plimsolls for PE and outdoor games – they should not be using their school shoes.



Healthy Snacks If your child would like a snack at morning break-time, we would be grateful if you could ensure that they bring in either fruit or vegetables. Please **do not** send your child to school with **sesame seeds, nuts, peanut butter or products containing nuts** for their morning snack or lunch as we do have children in the school who have severe allergies to such items. <u>Grapes should be cut in</u> half please. Fruit and/or vegetable morning snacks are provided by school for all children in

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, but children can bring in their own if they prefer. Please note these should <u>only</u> be fresh fruit or vegetables for morning snack.

We also ask children to bring in a **named, clear plastic** bottle for drinking water in class. These should not be used for drinking squash or fruit juice in class. Bottles are available from the school office for £1.00.

Topic Letters and Parent Information Topic letters and overview webs are being emailed out to you to help you find out about your child's topic and what they will be learning this term. More information about this can be found on our website and Google Classroom page.



Google Classroom We are continuing to use this to support learning in school and at home. Your login is the same as last year; please try to access Google Classroom over the coming week for more information about what is happening this term.

School Uniform and PE Kits It is lovely to see how smart the children look in their new school uniforms. Please could you ensure that all school uniform is **clearly named** so we can return any lost items as we do get a lot of lost property. Please make sure your child's PE kit is in school **each day**! It can be left on their peg in their cloakroom in a named bag. As we are outside for some PE and games, all children will need trainers or plimsolls at school. Please make sure children have micro-pore tape with them to cover earrings, or that they do not wear earrings to school on PE days.



Visitors and Volunteers We are very happy to have volunteers in school. If you would like to help in your child's class or know someone who would like to help out, please let the class teacher know and contact Rosie O'Hara in the school office on <u>rosie.o'hara@upperbeedingprimary.co.uk</u> You will need to have a DBS completed and sign our visitors and volunteers policy BEFORE you are able to come into school.















Milk If you would like your current Reception child to continue to have milk in school when they reach the age of 5, please visit <u>www.coolmilk.com</u> to order and pay for milk. If you have any questions please speak to Mrs Gilliam in the School Office. If your child is **under 5** we will register your child on your behalf as they are entitled to free milk.





Birthday Celebrations We always celebrate birthdays in school in both the classroom and in assembly. I know that some parents like to give their child something to share with their class, which is lovely, but please do not send in sweets – healthy alternatives are much more acceptable. Thank you for your support with this.

UIFSM Universal Infant Free School Meals has come to an end if your child has now left Year 2 as they are no longer eligible for these in Year 3 (except anyone entitled to FSM). If you would like your child to continue having hot school meals now they are in Year 3 and above, please register and order meals via <u>www.mealselector.co.uk</u>. If you have any queries regarding hot school meals, please speak to Mrs Gilliam in the School Office.

Extra-Curricular Clubs We are very pleased to have our external providers back in school this term and running clubs for the children after school. Details have already been emailed out as they became available, and the overview list of clubs has full details, but you can contact the providers direct for further information.
