Obviously we are all going to miss Mrs Wellby, but are very proud and excited that she has secured this wonderful opportunity and I am sure you will all join me in wishing her the very best

in her new adventure. For the next academic year, Mrs Stringer will be leading Year 3/4 and we are currently recruiting for a part-time music teacher. Mr Hughes will be working across all of Key Stage 2. Our two new teachers, Miss Bailey and Mrs Barnes are very excited to be joining us and the children will be meeting them over the coming weeks. We are also very proud of Mr Ruiz and Mr Gregory, who will both be leaving us at the end of term to undertake a teaching qualification in September. Next Year – Slight Change to Length of the School Day for Some Children

We have been reviewing the length of our school day for our Key Stage 1 children following the publication of the Schools White Paper where it is recommended that children in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 both have 32.5 hours on school site across the school week. In discussion with the Governors, we have decided to extend the Key Stage 1 day to finish at the same time as Key Stage 2 at 3.15pm, therefore bringing Key Stage 1 in line with this recommendation. Reception children will continue to finish at 3:10pm. We understand that for some parents this may cause concern

















when picking up children from different areas at the same time, but please rest reassured that staff will only release children from school when they see the responsible adult waiting to collect them. Please remember to let us know in writing if your child in Year 3/4 is allowed to meet you at an allocated place.

Upper KS2 Production – "Shakespeare Rocks!"

The children, Mr Moule and staff in Year 5/6 are currently busy rehearsing and practising every spare minute for our end of year production. This promises to be another spectacular show and one not to be missed!

We will be performing the play on **Monday 4th and Tuesday 5th of July at 6:00pm**. Tickets are available to purchase online via sQuid at a cost of £2.50 each. We are making this small charge for admission, as on previous occasions, and any monies raised are put towards the costs of staging this and other productions. Please note that tickets are limited to <u>two per family</u> to start with, this is over both performances, NOT each performance. If you would like to go on the waiting list for extra tickets, please contact the School Office in writing to request this, advising us of your preferred performance day and number of tickets required. By email is fine! Children in school will have the opportunity to see the dress rehearsal of the show during school time. Actual tickets will not be issued for these shows to save paper and cut costs, but they must be purchased via sQuid to secure a seat.

Bicycles and Scooters

We are quite concerned at the number of children who are cycling and/or scooting on school grounds at the beginning and end of the day. This can be very dangerous due to the number of children and parents on site at those times. Children coming to school on bikes/scooters must display a school cycle permit (available from the School Office) and all bikes and scooters must not be ridden unless outside the main school gates – we would appreciate your support with this. Please can ALL children please also make sure they are wearing an appropriate safety helmet.
