Dear Parents/Carers

This is the first letter you will receive today with a few general updates. At the end of today, there will be a detailed letter explaining what we have planned and the practical information for when school opens for further children.

Building Works Despite being in lockdown, essential maintenance work has been taking place in the Old Building. I am sure many of you will have seen the scaffolding! This has taken longer than expected due to the lockdown restrictions and it should all be completed by 1st June. Due to this delay, we will not be opening up the school to Year 6's until Wednesday 3rd June.

As part of the building works, we now have a lovely new side gate into the outside area of the Old Building, our green posts walkway between the Main Building and Old Building has been removed and all wiring is now underground. (I am sure all of FUBS will know that this is something we have been trying to get done for a long time!)

Unfortunately, our new shade / shelter off the storage building by the Structure has had to be postponed and this work is now planned to take place in the Summer Holidays.
