Dear Parents

Welcome back! I do hope you all had a lovely Summer break. The children have certainly been keen to tell us all about their adventures and what they have been up to.



We have had a super first few days back at school with smiles from everyone. I am sure you have all noticed the fabulous new bike shelter we have had built with money raised by FUBS.

Three classrooms in Y3/4 have all had to have new floors and sinks over the summer due to a water leak. We would also like to say a big thank you to Mr Willmott (parent) who, over the Summer, did a lot of work renovating our Reception playhouse.

**School Uniform** It is lovely to see how smart the children look in their new school uniforms. Please could you ensure that all school uniform is clearly named so we can return any lost items. Can I also remind you that we encourage black or brown shoes that children can actively play in, navy trousers or skirt/pinafore, gold polo shirt, and navy cardigan or sweatshirt/jumper. Polo shirt sleeves should not be rolled up and if shorts are worn, these should be tailored and navy in colour. Fleece are for outside wear only and not instead of a sweatshirt or cardigan. Children will be asked to take them off inside. We also request that children wear the appropriate coloured socks or tights for school: black, grey, white or blue. Summer dresses of yellow or blue can still be worn while the sun is out. PE kits of navy shorts and house colour t-shirts should also be clearly named. It is beneficial for children to have a PE t-shirt in their house colour and Year 1 children will be allocated a house by the end of next week. Reception children should have a plain white t-shirt for PE.



**After School and Lunchtime Clubs** Please find attached the lists of after school and lunchtime clubs on offer to your children this term. Please note that the **start dates** for the clubs do vary and some will be dependent on weather. We also have some before school clubs.

We are very lucky to have so many staff who are happy to run a variety of different activities for the children before, during and after school. This term we are trialling a variety of sports clubs as well as a lot of others. Places for some clubs are limited so please register interest as soon as possible.

**Topic Letters and Parent Information** Over the next few days the children will be coming home with letters about the topic and what they will be learning about this term. More information about this can be found on our website and VLE class pages.

For parents who were unable to make the Welcome Meetings last term, there are also helpful leaflets about each year group. If you would like one of these, please pop in and ask the class teacher. These will also be available on the VLE.



**Healthy Schools** If your child would like a snack at morning break-time, we would be grateful if you could ensure that they bring in either fruit or vegetables. Please **do not** send your child to school with **nuts, peanut butter or products containing nuts** for their morning snack or lunch as we do have children in the school who have severe allergies to such items. We also encourage parents to think about **healthy alternatives** to sweets and cakes if their child would like to celebrate their birthday with their class. Thank you for your support with this.



We also ask children to bring in a named, **clear** plastic bottle for drinking water in class. These should not be used for drinking squash or fruit juice. Bottles are available from the school office priced £1.00.
